German Definition of Bioeconomy

(Broad approach)

Knowledge-based production and use of renewable resources to provide products, processes and services in all economic sectors, within the framework of an economic system which is viable for the future

❖ → Value chains of food, feed, fuel (bioenergy) but also of bio-based chemicals, technical materials (bio plastic, WPC,...) drugs, cosmetics,...


2009: Bioeconomy Council established


2010: "National Research Strategy

2013: "National **Policy Strategy** on Bioeconomy" (BMEL)









National Research Strategy BioEconomy 2030


National Policy Strategy on Bioeconomy

- Linking Circular Economy with Bioeconomy




