BIO INNO HUB – CORE VALUE PROPOSITION




BIO INNO HUB as **holistic integrator** ... bringing together various disciplines, network partners and stakeholders (industry, academia, public organisations) in a most valuable way

BIO INNO HUB as **knowledge-spreading educator** ... deriving new bio-based competences and letting a broad audience benefit from the hub's successful initiatives





- Ensure holistic, futureoriented perspective





- Finalize BIO INNO HUB business logic (incl. implementation plan) & portfolio of pilot projects (incl. roadmap)


